

# Disease Management Sudoku

The object of the game is to fill in all of the blank squares with the correct letters.

1. Each **row** of 6 must include all letters of the puzzle word once in any order.
2. Each **column** of 6 must include all letters of the puzzle word once in any order.
3. Each **subsection** (2x3) must include all letters of the puzzle word once in any order. Notice that subsections are separated by bold lines.

## Directions

For example, given the following grid and puzzle word "FAMILY":

FAMILY

- I** Because there is an "I" in the upper row of the middle right subsection, I know an "I" goes in the lower row of the shaded subsection

Because the other 2 squares have other letters already in them, I know that the "I" goes in the lower right corner of the shaded subsection

- L** Because there is an "L" in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> columns and the shaded subsection already has a "Y" in one of the 2<sup>nd</sup> column squares, I know that an "L" goes in the other 2<sup>nd</sup> column square

- F** Because there is already an "F" in the 1st column and only 2 squares left in the middle left subsection, I know that the "F" goes in the upper right corner of the shaded subsection

- A** Because it's the only letter left and the only square still open, I know the "A" goes in the upper left corner of the shaded subsection
